





INCENTIVES GRANTED TO PROJECTS LOCATED IN REGIONAL **DEVELOPMENT ZONES**

The privileges of regional development investments are granted to the sectors of industry, tourism, crafts and a number of service activities that are performed in the zones encouraging regional development.

ADVANTAGES GRANTED TO PROJECTS LOCATED IN THE THREE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT ZONES

- Total deduction of income or profits generated by ents from the tax base during the first 5 or 10 **years** of activity according to the Zone and **deduction** within the limit of 50% of such income or profits for the following 10 years for the priority areas.
- Subsidy of the employer's contribution to statutory social security scheme related to wages for a period ranging from 5 to 10 years depending on the area.
- Premium ranging from 8% to 25% of the investment cost, working capital included, capped at 0.5 or 1 or 1.5 million dinars according to the zone.
- Partial contribution to infrastructure expenditure: 25%, **75% or 85%** of the amounts incurred by the company.

ADVANTAGES GRANTED TO PROJECTS LOCATED IN THE 2ND GROUP ZONES AND PRIORITY ZONES

- **Exemption** from the contribution to the Housing Promotion Fund for employees in the first five years of operation.
- Exemption without time limitations from the tax on vocational training (TFP).
