



1. Minimum wages

The Guaranteed Inter-Professionnal Minimum Wage (**SMIG**) and the Guaranteed Agricultural Minimum Wage (**SMAG**) are established by Decree No73-247of May 26th,1973.

The salary regards workers of both sexes aged 18 years at least.

The transportation allowance for employees paid the guaranteed minimum wage (SMIG) in non-agricultural sectors governed by the Labour Code is set at 26.112 TND per month as established by Decree No. 82-503 of 16 March 1982 and supplemented by Decree n ° 2015-1764 published in JORT No. 91 of November 13, 2015.

In Tunisia, the national telecommunications market has three operators: Tunisie Telecom, Ooredoo or Orange Tunisie as well as a virtual mobile operator: Lycamobile.

The minimum rates of mobile telephony in Tunisia vary between 0.035 dinar and 0.090 dinar depending on the operator and its offer.
